

# EU T+1 Industry Committee

## Summary of Conclusions, Monday 14 July 2025

### Executive Summary:

The focus of the meeting was to review the status of the existing areas in High-Level Roadmap that require further clarification and to discuss the next steps for the implementation of the communication plan. The chair shared an update on discussion with public authorities,

### Main takeaways:

- Work is ongoing to establish task forces on SSIs, Partial Settlement, Potential Settlement Optimisation and unharmonized insolvency protection. This is to address the relevant recommendations in the High-Level Road map that require review or assessment by relevant taskforces. Respective technical workstream leads shared an update on the process and the task forces are currently being set up. Intention is to keep the TF participation lean.
- Communication taskforce has been established, and periodic meetings will start soon.
- Preliminary discussions have started with public authorities with an emphasized on the importance of coordination between T+1 IC and public authorities to avoid an overlap and duplication of tasks.

### H2 2025 Priorities:

Priorities for the second half of the year will include:

- Review of feedback on the High-Level Roadmap, and publishing of clarifications where necessary.
- Identification of, and further work on, open actions in the High-Level Roadmap (e.g. development of market practices)
- Development of Industry Playbook
- Launch of a Market Survey with the goal of gauging market readiness
