Summary of Conclusions, Tuesday 9 December 2025

Executive Summary:

The meeting focus was on the deliverables, the three active Task Forces on SSIs, SFTs and Partial Settlement Market Practice and the process for the Industry Committee to endorse these in a written procedure. The Chair updated the participants on the recent Coordination Committee meeting and an update on the Market Readiness Survey responses was received. Testing TF shared an update on the foreseen joint work with the UK AST testing workstream.

Q4 2025 Priorities

Priorities for the fourth quarter of the year will include:

- Endorse the deliverables the three task forces and subsequently prepare them for publication
- Develop and publish an addendum to High-level Road map to provide details for certain recommendations. Task Forces that are not able to achieve this by predefined time will deliver an interim report.
- Finalise and publish v.1 of the T+1 Handbook (User manual)
- EU T+1 Testing Task Force to start preparing its report to the T+1 Industry Committee, expected to be delivered by end of Q1 2026
- Summarise results of Market Readiness Survey
