Summary of Conclusions, Monday 22 December 2025

Executive Summary:

The meeting focus was on the deliverables of the three active Task Forces on SSIs, SFTs and Partial Settlement Market Practice, which were published on the EU T+1 website earlier on the same day, as well as on the progress of the T+1 Market Readiness Survey for which deadline of responses was extended to 2 January 2026. The Survey responses would be published at the end of January, and this would be followed by a hybrid public event in Milan on 2 February.

The Testing TF shared an update on the foreseen joint work with the UK AST testing workstream and intention to launch a common UK/EU methodology in an event in London on 25 March.

Q1 2026 Priorities

Priorities for the first quarter of the year will include:

- Finalise and publish v.1 of the T+1 Handbook (User manual)
- TFs and the relevant Workstreams to conduct the follow-up work to the published reports where relevant
- EU T+1 Testing Task Force to start preparing its report to the T+1 Industry Committee, expected to be published in Q1 2026
- Summarise and publish results of Market Readiness Survey by end of January.
