

## The EU T+1 Industry Committee



### Summary of Conclusions, Tuesday 13 January 2026

#### Executive Summary:

The Industry Committee discussed the input received on the T+1 Industry Survey and organisation of a public event on release of the Survey results on 2 February afternoon in PwC tower in Milan.

The Industry Committee agreed to aim to release the first version of the Handbook by end of January.

Follow-up work of the TFs on SSIs, SFT optimisation and Partial Settlement market practice will be launched in the coming weeks.

The Testing TF shared an update on on-going joint work with the UK AST testing workstream. A public event to the launch a common UK/EU methodology will take place in London on 25 March. 2<sup>nd</sup> event, which is a follow-up to the March 25 event is planned to take place in the EU on 20 April.

#### Q1 2026 Priorities

Priorities for the first quarter of the year will include:

- Finalise and publish v.1 of the T+1 Handbook
- TFs and the relevant Workstreams to conduct the follow-up work to the published reports where relevant
- EU T+1 Testing Task Force to start preparing its report to the T+1 Industry Committee, to have it ready to be published on 25 March
- Summarise and publish results of Market Readiness Survey by end of January
- Updating the FAQ on the website
