### Summary of Conclusions, Monday 23 March 2026

#### Executive Summary:

The Industry Committee had initial discussions on potential follow-up to the release of testing report in form of governance arrangements for testing. A follow-up discussion on this was agreed to take place in the next Industry Committee meeting.

Timetable and planning of the next EU T+1 Readiness Survey was presented and discussed in more detail. The aim is to publish the survey late in April.

#### Q2 2026 Priorities

Priorities for the second quarter of the year will include:

- TFs and the relevant Workstreams to conduct the follow-up work to the published reports where relevant
- Release the T+1 Readiness Survey, collect and publish its results
- Publish 2<sup>nd</sup> release of T+1 Handbook
- To increase communication reaching beyond Europe and emphasising the message that strong early momentum must now translate into concrete operational change across the industry.
