Summary of Conclusions, Monday 27 April 2026

Executive Summary:

2nd release of the Handbook and Checklist were deemed to be ready shared with the IC for its feedback.

The next EU T+1 Readiness Survey was agreed to be launched no later than on May 4. The survey would run for ca 4 weeks.

The Industry Committee continued discussion on next steps, open points and forthcoming deliverable on the SFT Gating Event.

Q2 2026 Priorities

Priorities for the second quarter of the year will include:

- SFT Optimisation TF to draft additional guidance and market practice for the use of the Gating event
- Release 2nd version of T+1 Readiness Survey, collect and publish its results
- Publish 2nd release of T+1 Handbook
- Publish T+1 Checklist
- To increase communication reaching beyond Europe and emphasising the message that strong early momentum must now translate into concrete operational change across the industry.
