

The EU T+1 Industry Committee

Summary of Conclusions of the meeting on Monday 29 June 2026



The Industry Committee agreed that it has delivered the necessary guidance and a wide range of documents, which allow preparation for transition to T+1. The work plan for second half of 2026 was agreed as follows:

Q3-Q4 2026 Work plan

- Continuous communication efforts, primarily using website and other online channels
- Preparation of Governance arrangement for testing phase
- Launching work to support transition week preparations.
- Exploring ways and metrics to measure settlement efficiency before and after transition to T+1

As of July, the EU T+1 IC will meet regularly, once every three weeks.

Results of 2nd T+1 Readiness survey were presented and discussed. The results will be published in a hybrid event in Paris on 3 July.

ECSDA representatives presented CSD T+1 Implementation Dashboard that ECSDA had published on its website.

Document *Additional Guidance: Standards for the storage and exchange of SSIs: alignment between the EU and the UK* was agreed to be published on the website.

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
