

The EU T+1 Industry Committee

Summary of Conclusions of the meeting on Monday 20 July 2026



The EU T+1 Industry Committee agreed to launch task forces one focusing on transition period and another to facilitate testing activities and promote information sharing on testing. Terms of reference of both task forces would be drafted ahead of the next meeting with the aim to approve them in the meeting.

The EU T+1 Industry Committee had a first discussion on common metrics for settlement efficiency for the EU with the aim to assess how settlement efficiency evolves after transition to T+1. Discussion on this area will continue also with the relevant market infrastructures that can provide the relevant data.

The next meeting was agreed to be preponed to 3 August.

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
